

Registration and Change of address

Registration: People who live in Murcia, coming from another municipality or country and people who were not previously registered.

Change of address: Registered people who want to update their data due to a change of address within the same municipality.

Requirements:

- Spanish citizens.
- Foreign community citizens.
- Non-EU foreign citizens.
- Minors.

If you are not the owner or tenant of the property in which you are going to register

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

- 1. Registration form.
- 2. Photocopy of the DNI, passport or NIE of the person who has signed in this section of the "registration form".
- 3. If the authorising party is the owner, the original of one of the documents detailed in section 1 must be provided, certifying that this person is the owner.
- 4. If the authorising party is the tenant, the originals of the documents required in section 2 and a photocopy of the landlord's DNI must be provided; or any bill from Water of Murcia, landline telephone, Gas or Electricity.





Facts to consider

- If you request the registration form "Via Telematic", or by telephone (900 222 900), the issuing time may be delayed..
- For matters related to the census, they must be carried out at the headquarters of the Statistics and Notifications Service. **THEY ARE ONLY AVAILABLE UPON APPOINTMENT**

Timetable:

- Mornings from 9:00 to 14:30.
- Afternoons every Wednesday from 9:00 to 14:00 and from 16:00 to 18:30, except the afternoons of Christmas, New Year, Epiphany, Easter, Local festivities Week, and the afternoons of July and August due to the high temperatures.



Apply for your NIE

Documents to be provided

Application form in official model (EX-15) duly completed and signed in duplicate by the foreigner. This form can be obtained HERE



Copy of the full passport, travel document or registration card, or identity card if the applicant is a citizen of the Union.

Communication of the economic, professional or social reasons that justify the application.

Note: as a general practice, copies of documents must be provided and originals must be presented at the time of application



Work allowance during your studies

Student Visa: Highlights



1. Work up to 30 hours per week. The Spanish student visa allows you to work part-time during your stay

2. Residence permit for jobseeker´s students. You

can apply to extend your stay for an additional year for the purpose of looking for a job or setting up a business



3. Work permit after completing your studies. If you receive a job offer, you can apply for a long-term work visa.

Once you have finished your studies you will have access to change your student visa for a new status visa. To do so, you will need:

- Demonstrate the possession of 6.500€ in case of jobseeker's student permit
- Show proof of having passed successfully your masters.

ENAE offers 1 free consultation with our visa partners once you are admitted.

Your student visa is linked to the duration of your studies. Once your first year of classes is finished, you will have to renew, move to a work permit or get back to your origin country.



Students are allowed to work on a part time basis whilst pursuing their degrees, as long as the job is compatible with the live lessons. Students do not need any kind of authorization apart from its visa in the following cases:

Higher Education

 Official training for employment or aimed at obtaining a certificate of vocational qualification.

 Training aimed at obtaining the technical aptitude certificate or vocational qualification required for the exercise of a specific occupation.

HOW TO ARRIVE IN MURCIA



By plane: Wherever you live abroad, you will most likely have to come by plane. You may fly directly to Murcia airport, or you may arrive at Alicante international airport (only 50 minutes from the city) or Madrid International (3 hours by car).

From here, you will be able to get to Murcia by public transport: Train (Renfe) or by Bus (Alsa)



Train: You can check in the website how to arrive to Murcia by Train. Renfe is the public railway provider in Spain

Bus: You can get to Murcia by bus from any of the main airports in Spain. Please check their website for more information.



Blablacar: User community that connects drivers with empty seats with passengers looking for a lift. Blablacar: User community that connects drivers with energy services of the trips of the days in advance to any Operates online www.blablacar.es, where trips are published two or three days in advance to any destination in Spain and Europe. The driver is contacted and the trip is organised



Taxi Transfer: You can request ENAE to organize for you a taxi transfer from any airport in Spain. Please contact your agent for further info.



Holiday Breaks



Banks: 9:00AM to 2:00PM, Closed in weekends









Bank Account



- Main Banks branches: Banco Santander, BBVA, La Caixa, ING
- **Documents to be provided:** Student card, the address where the student will live during the course, the address of the student's own country and passport.
- Usually has no or low operating fees.
- If it is linked to a debit card, it allows you to:
 - > Do shopping on and off line.
 - > Withdraw cash.
 - > Direct debit of your payments (rent, electricity, etc.)

Note: It is important that you check that your credit cards are chipped, as some countries in Europe do not accept traditional banded cards.


Living in Murcia
